- Minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- Must attend the Banquet, February 28, 2020
- Recipient of the award must attend a four-year institution or military service academy.
- Submit applications on line by Friday, February 7, 2020

Procedure: The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must complete the electronic application personally.

- Three brief letters of reference, at least one from a Scouting leader. Letters should include contact information.
- Fill out the application form completely and submit via email. Also attach the recommendation letters and email the packet to **caryl.sharpe@scouting.org** and **copy a parent or guardian.**
- One- page essay discussing how Scouting has influenced your life and your character.
- Eagle Scout Project- One- page description of your Eagle project.
- **No paper submissions will be accepted.**
